INFLUENCE OF COLLABORATION AND SOCIAL INTERACTION IN LEARNING

- Students using the target language in real life scenarios in a meaningful way.
- For example, after learning the command form of the verbs, cooking Spanish tortillas in class using the command form.

It means peel, doesn't it?

What does "pelar" mean? I forgot!

Oh yeah! Thanks, Mike!

According to Snowman et al. (2009) cognitive constructivism is "...assimilating and accommodating new information into existing schemes in an attempt to construct an understanding of the world in which we live and the rules by which it is governed" (p.340).
