

Cognitive Constructivism & Collaboration

- Construction of knowledge structures by requiring to engage in higher order thinking and problem solving.
- For example, students reading a text and understanding it enough to be able to produce a dialogue based on the characters and plot of the story.

Jean Piaget states that collaboration among peers hasten the decline of egocentrism and allows the development of more advanced ways of understanding and dealing with the world (Snowman et al., 2009, p.409).
